10. Section 44-90 of the City of Houston Code of Ordinances: "Nothing contained in this division shall be construed or have the effect to license, permit, authorize or legalize any machine, device, table or coin-operated machine, the keeping, exhibition, operation, displaying or maintenance of which is illegal or in violation of any article of the Penal Code of this state, or the constitution of this state."

It is unlawful for an owner to display or exhibit for commercial use any coin-operated machine which does not have a decal evidencing payment of the occupation tax properly attached to the machine. The machine must not be plugged in without the decal. After January 31st of each year, coin-operated machine(s) upon which the tax required has not been paid or upon which the decal is not PROPERLY displayed may be SEALED. For each machine sealed there will be a \$250.00 penalty and a \$5.00 seal removal fee. The owner or agent must appear in person to pay the penalty and seal removal fees. Upon proof of payment of the occupation tax (\$15.00), the penalty (\$250.00) and the removal fee (\$5.00), authorization will be given for removal of the seals. Only cash or bank-issued cashier's check will be accepted. If decals are being replaced as a result of theft or destruction, a police report must accompany your application for a prorated rate.

The sole owner or partner or officer or agent and recordkeeper must sign. An agent must submit a written power of attorney. I am applying for occupation tax permits for coin-operated amusement machine(s) which are listed in this application. I (We) certify that all information submitted in this application for tax permit(s) and any attachments is true and correct.

**REGISTRATION FOR AMUSEMENT REDEMPTION MACHINES ONLY**

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Amusement Redemption machine means a recreational machine that provides the user with an opportunity to receive something of value other than a right to replay and in which credits, or the equivalent thereof, are accumulated when: a particular configuration of like symbols is displayed in a random fashion by the machine; symbols or numbers are matched to a randomly selected symbol or number determined by the machine; a combination of cards is arrived at and valued in a traditional hierarchy for purposes of poker; or a combination of cards is arrived at and points assigned for purposes of blackjack. Note: A building, facility, or other place that contains one or more amusement redemption machines is considered a "game room". Game Rooms are required to have a license, issued by the City of Houston.
