#### THE PERMIT APPLICATION MUST BE ACCOMPANIED BY:

- 1. A Certified copy of the Assumed Name Certificate as filed in compliance with the Assumed Business of Professional Name Act, provided the applicant is to operate the enterprise under an assumed name.
- 2. A certified copy of all Articles of Incorporation together with all documentation thereto, provided the applicant is a Texas Corporation.
- 3. A certified copy of the certificate to transact / conduct business in the State of Texas together with all documentation thereto, provided the applicant is a foreign corporation.
- 4. A certified copy of the Certificate of Limited Partnership, together with all documentation thereto, provided the applicant(s) is a limited partnership under the laws of the State of Texas.
- 5. A certified copy of the Certificate of Limited Partnership and all qualification documentation thereto, provided the applicant is a foreign Limited Partnership.
