1) Existing roof covering and felt materials will be completely removed and disposed of properly. 2) All roof decking will be inspected; decking materials will be replaced if not structurally sound. 3) Install or replace all missing, rusted, and/or damaged flashing, counter-flashing, roof vents, ve caps, and metal edging with all new materials. 4) Inspect all roof drains and repair or replace when necessary to ensure the roof drainage sufficient to prevent excessive accumulation of water. 5) Install all new roofing materials with the appropriate class roofing as required by the building code for the occupancy and construction type of the building being re-roofed. 6) Ensure all fire retardant requirements are maintained.
