
Where Do I Begin?

Building permits may be obtained at the Houston Permitting Center, 1002 Washington Avenue. Once you are ready to apply for the permit, you will need to have the following items:

- Site Plan
- Recorded Subdivision Plat
- Survey (old or new)
- Architectural or Engineered Drawings

Customers are welcome to come by the Permitting Center for assistance with preliminary drawings, questions, or other concerns prior to applying for a permit. Start at the information desk on the first floor. Customer service representatives are available to assist you and direct you to the appropriate department(s).

CARPORTS



Things to know:

No portion of a carport may be located within either the set back or the Right of Way. Building setback lines may be established by a subdivision plat, deed restrictions or by ordinance. Property lines or Right of Way lines are typically located behind the sidewalk (see diagram). Owners of carports that encroach the setback line have two options: 1) remove the carport from the building setback line; or 2) seek a variance from the Planning Commission. Planning staff can provide guidance on this process.
