METRO Light Rail Temporary Banner Application
Ordinance # 2010-69 Effective January 27th, 2010

This application must be applied for and a permit issued in advance of the installation of the Light Rail Temporary Banner.

Temporary Banners for Businesses Adjacent to Light Rail Construction Projects: Section 4608(q) of the Sign Code limits the size and duration that Temporary Banners for Light Rail construction may be displayed. Temporary Banner may not exceed four feet by eight feet in size and must be at all times securely attached to and maintained flush with an exterior wall of the business. Only one such temporary banner may be used on any premises at any time during an ongoing light rail construction project immediately adjacent to the premises on which the business is located. A temporary banner may be displayed at all times during a display period for which a permit has been issued. Each such display period shall last until the light rail construction project is accepted by the City, and shall require the issuance of a separate permit and the payment of appropriate site inspection \$70.00, plan exam \$ 70.00, construction permit \$ 70.00 and administration fees \$ 25.00 as set forth in Section 117 of this Code.
