# 2022 PPSLA COMPLETION INSTRUCTIONS

- THE PPLSA HAS BEEN EXTENSIVELY REVISED
- Two industry meetings were held in 2021
- The purpose of this presentation is to assist in filling out the PPSLA and compiling the exhibits
- THE NEW PPSLA SHOULD BE FILLED OUT AND RETURNED TO AUTO DEALERS BY APRIL 29, 2022
- As with the PATSA, only one copy is required

- SECTION 1.02: THE NEW MINIMUM SIZE IS 1.25 ACRES. ALL CURRENT STORAGE LOTS ARE GRANDFATHERED IN
- SECTION 6.08: GARAGEKEEPER'S INSURANCE
  - \$500,000 IF THE STORAGE LOT CAN HOLD 100 VEHICLES OR FEWER
  - \$1,000,000 IF THE STORAGE LOT CAN HOLD MORE THAN 100 VEHICLES

- SECTION 6.08: BOND
  - THE BOND AMOUNT SHALL BE CALCULATED BY AVERAGING THE PREVIOUS 12 MONTHS OF RELEASE FEES PAID TO THE CITY.
  - The bond will be used to satisfy any unpaid release fees collected pursuant to Section 8-123(e) of the Code of Ordinances

- SECTION 6.26: THE WINDOW AT WHICH CUSTOMERS PAY FOR THE VEHICLES MUST BE FREE OF TINT OR OTHER OBSTRUCTION. IT ALSO CANNOT BE AT A HEIGHT THAT DOES NOT ALLOW THE CUSTOMER TO SEE THE ATTENDANT CLEARLY
  - PHOTOS OF THE WINDOW MUST BE SUBMITTED WITH THE PPSLA
  - Lots not in compliance will not be given a PPSLA.
  - This is required of all lots. No lots will be grandfathered

- The release fee collected pursuant to Section 8-123(e) is for all nonconsent tows, regardless of the origin of the tow, including private property
- The fees are due on the 15<sup>th</sup> of the month after they are collected
- FAILURE TO REMIT BY THE END OF THE MONTH WILL RESULT IN THE SUSPENSION OF STORAGE LOT OPERATIONS UNDER THE CONTRACT
- FAILURE TO REMIT BY THE END OF THE NEXT MONTH WILL RESULT IN TERMINATION OF THE AGREEMENT AND THE FORFEITURE OF THE BOND

#### RELEASE FEE EXAMPLE

- FEES COLLECTED IN JANUARY 2022 ARE DUE BY FEBRUARY 15, 2022
- FAILURE TO REMIT BY FEBRUARY 28, 2022, WILL RESULT IN THE SUSPENSION OF STORAGE OF HPD TOWS
- FAILURE TO REMIT BY MARCH 31, 2022, WILL RESULT IN TERMINATION OF THE AGREEMENT

- FILL OUT SECTIONS 1.01, 1.02, 1.03, 1.04, 1.05, AND 5.01
- PAYMENT OF THE PPSLA FEE IS NOW DUE UPON SUBMISSION FOR ALL NEW CONTRACTS.
  CURRENT CONTRACTS EXPIRE IN SEPTEMBER SO NO MONEY IS DUE AT THIS TIME

- Another copy of the survey is **not** needed unless the boundaries of the storage lot have changed
